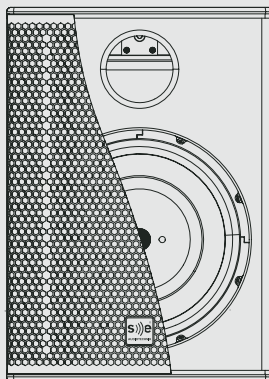
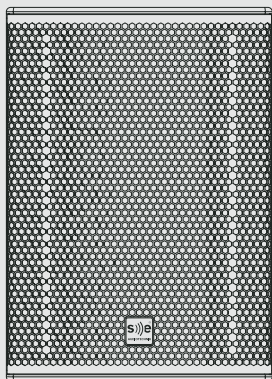

COX-Line speakers offer uniform coverage characteristics as all sound waves are emitted from the same source. The COX-Line's coaxial system allows for a smooth transition between the high and mid/low frequencies, resulting in a natural and coherent sound experience.

While **COX 8 MKII** offers an optimised sound image with precise localisation and differentiation of sound signals as well as easy installation due to its low weight and small dimensions, **COX 12 MKII** impresses with an extended low frequency range and higher power handling.

The versatile and practical COX-Line speaker systems offer an effective combination of size, performance and ease of use. With its features, available accessories and system integration capabilities with other SE AUDIOTECHNIK products, COX-Line speakers are a great choice for installations, mobile applications and stage monitoring.

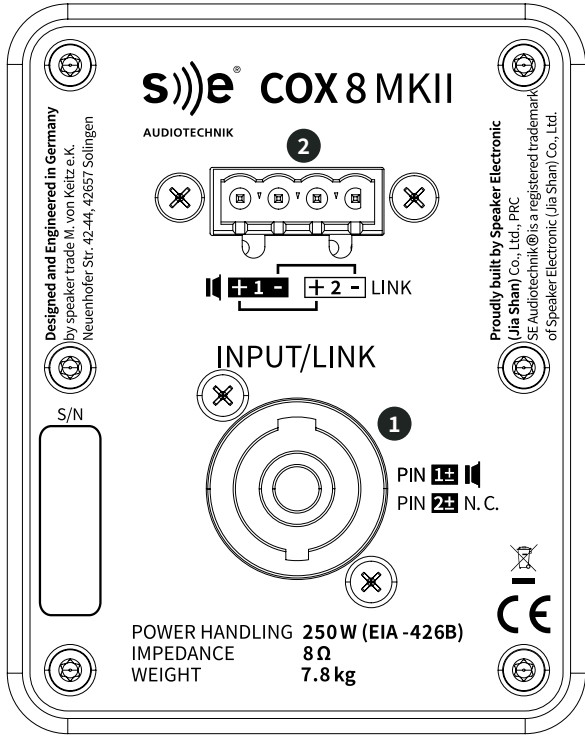


Figure 1. COX 8 MKII - Connection terminal.

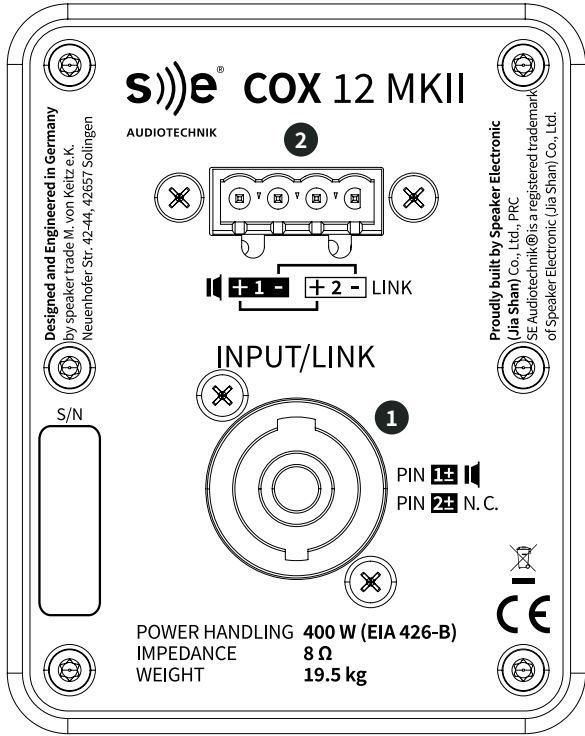


Figure 2. COX 12 MKII - Connection terminal.

WIRING AND POWERING

Audio signals are entered and/or passed through a Neutrik® speakON® NL4 connector. These wires should be connected as shown below:

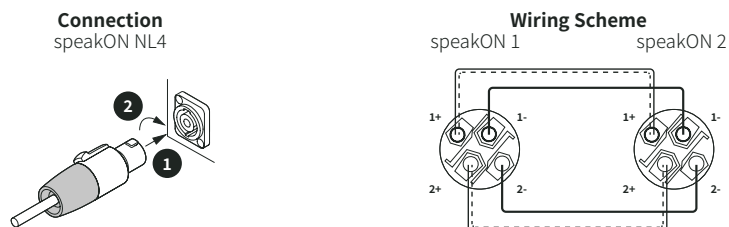


Figure 3. SpeakON® NL4 plug-in and link cable connection.

It is recommended to use cables with at least 18 AWG conductor size. For long cable lengths, the maximum conductor size is 14 AWG. Those wires must be assembled by a qualified technician.

To ensure the correct and safe behavior of the equipment, use a sufficiently powerful amplifier. As a general rule, its rated power should be at least twice the rated power of the loudspeaker. Keep in mind that daisy chain connections reduce the total impedance, so please keep in mind the amplifier's capabilities.

In addition, when using passive loudspeakers as the **COX 8 MKII** and **COX 12 MKII**, both mechanical and thermal protection techniques should be implemented. SE AUDIOTECHNIK'S drivers are designed to reach lower stress in the suspension parts at greater excursion. However, these protections will assure the proper behavior of the equipment, its care and safety, and can maximize the performance of the whole system.



The mechanical protection of a loudspeaker controls the excursion of the cone, so its physical limits are not exceeded. This can be done by filtering the signal below the safe range of the loudspeaker.

Thermal protection controls the energy of the loudspeaker in the long term, keeping its temperature under safe levels. This is achieved by limiting the RMS voltage applied, where the maximum allowable value is its average power handling. This protection depends also on the time constants selected to trigger and release the limiter.



If equalization is needed, it is recommended to reduce levels in the undesired frequency ranges, instead of boosting the desired ones. This guarantees maximum dynamic range.



If you are using an SE AUDIOTECHNIK I-Line or L-Line amplifier, you can use the built-in presets for simple and safe setup of the loudspeaker systems.

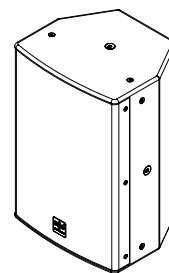


Figure 4. Vertically, as a stand-alone loudspeaker for full-range reinforcement.

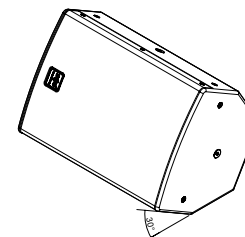


Figure 5. Horizontally, as floor stage monitor.

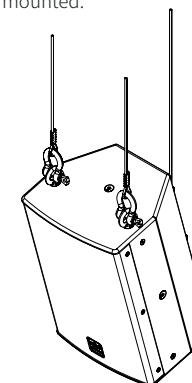


Figure 6. Hanged from the ceiling using the M5 and M8 screw threads.

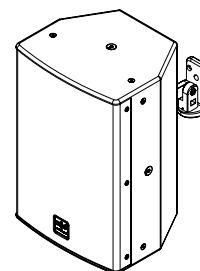


Figure 7. Wall mounted using the SMB (Smart Mounting Bracket).

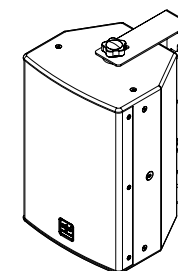


Figure 8. Wall mounted using the WMB (Wall Mounting Bracket). Also allows other mounting variants.

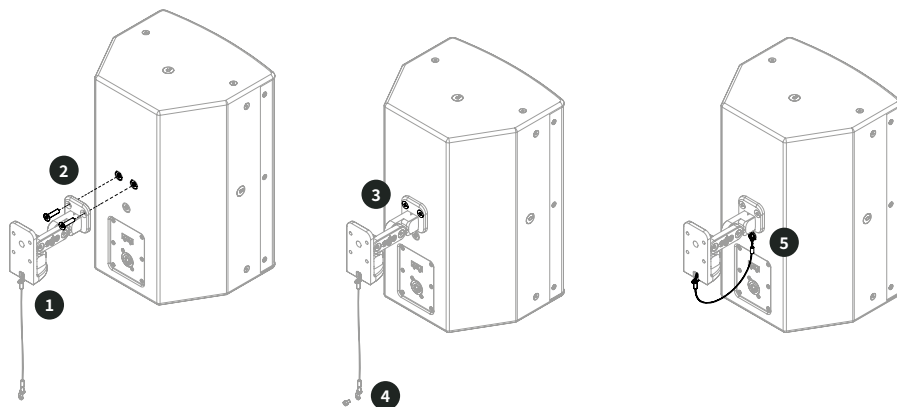


Figure 9. COX 8 MKII - Installation with SMB (Smart Mounting Bracket).

- 1 Attach the wall bracket to the desired position on a load-bearing wall using appropriate screws and wall plugs for the type of wall.
- 2 Position the SMB wall bracket over the mounting points provided on the loudspeaker cabinet and have the appropriate SMB screws ready.
- 3 Tighten the SMB screws with a suitable screwdriver until the wall bracket is securely fastened to the speaker cabinet.
- 4 Ensure that you have the safety catch and the appropriate fastening screw readily available.
- 5 Attach one end of the safety catch to the wall bracket and the other end to the speaker cabinet at the mounting point using the safety catch screw.

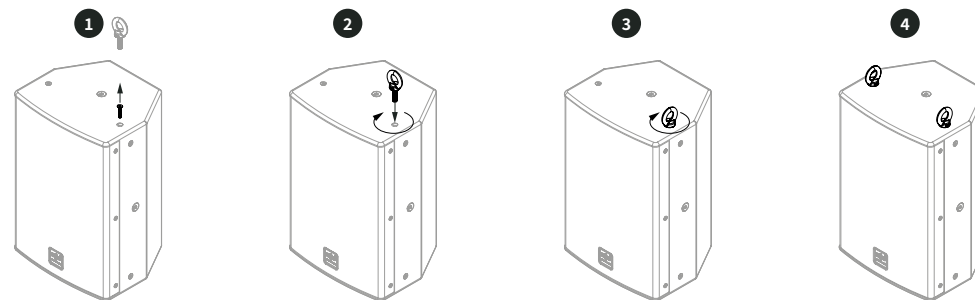
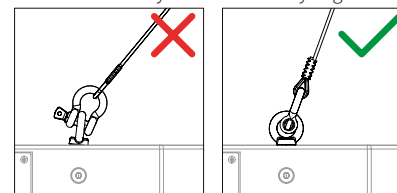
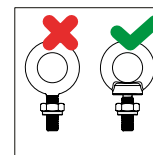


Figure 10. COX 8 MKII - Preparing for flown installation.

- 1 Remove the screwed-in countersink screw and have the eyebolt ready.
- 2 Screw in the eyebolt in the flying point thread.
- 3 Ensure that the eye bolt is correctly aligned so that the shackle is secure and free from torsion.
- 4 Continue with all other desired flight points. Use at least two eyebolts for load distribution and secure fastening and one eyebolt on the back for aligning the flown speaker.

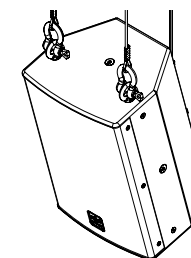


Figure 11. COX 8 MKII - Example of flown installation.

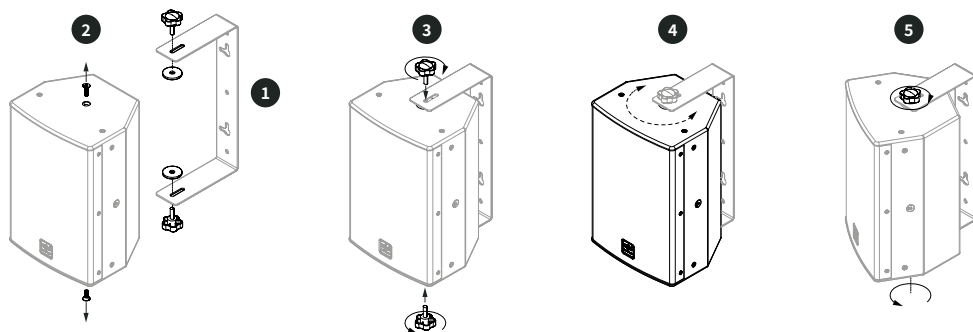


Figure 12. COX 8 MKII - COX 8 MKII - Installation with Wall Mount Bracket.

- 1 Attach the wall bracket to the desired position on a load-bearing wall using appropriate screws and wall plugs for the type of wall.
- 2 Prepare the knurled screws and washers and remove the countersink screw that is screwed in.
- 3 Position the loudspeaker cabinet between the arms of the WB wall bracket, ensuring that the mounting points align correctly with the slotted holes in the bracket. Place washers between the cabinet's mounting points and the slotted holes in the bracket. Insert the knurled screws through the slotted holes in the bracket, making sure they are guided through the washers. Tighten the knurled screws until the loudspeaker is securely fastened but can still be rotated.
- 4 Align the speaker to direct sound towards the desired area.
- 5 After aligning the speaker, tighten the knurled screws by hand and remember to attach the safety catch.

The **COX 12 MKII** cabinet's design offers great versatility for different needs and applications. This coaxial loudspeaker can be used on the floor, standing, pole mounted, suspended or wall mounted.

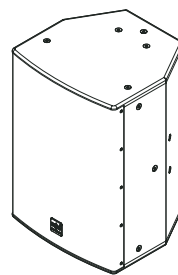


Figure 13. Vertically, as a stand-alone loudspeaker for full-range reinforcement.

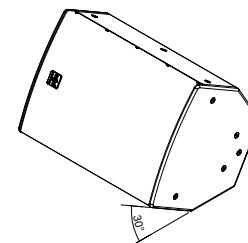


Figure 14. Horizontally, as floor stage monitor.

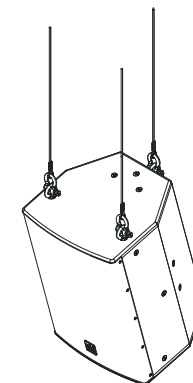


Figure 15. Hung from the ceiling using the M8 screw threads.

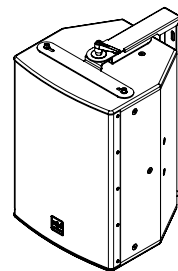


Figure 16. Flexible mounted using the WMB (Wall Mounting Bracket).

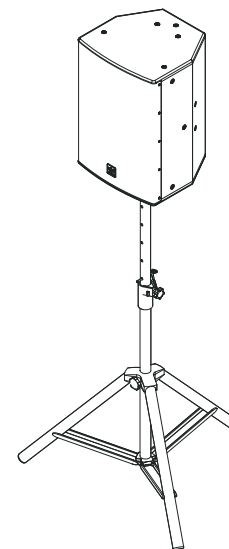


Figure 17. Mounted on top of a loudspeaker stand or a subwoofer using a speaker spacer rod.

INSTALLATION COX 12 MKII ON A STAND

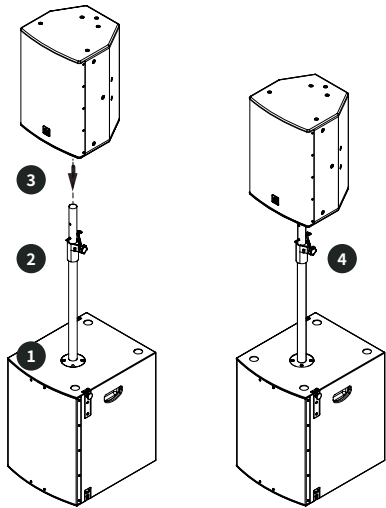


Figure 18. COX 12 MKII - Installation on top of a subwoofer.

- 1 Insert the speaker spacer rod into the mounting flange of the subwoofer
- 2 Set the desired height of the speaker spacer rod. Insert the speaker spacer rod into the mounting flange of the subwoofer
- 3 Place the speaker cabinet onto the spacer rod, ensuring that the 36mm socket on the underside of the housing is securely connected to the spacer rod.
- 4 Please check the assembly to ensure that the locking bolts have been inserted and secured.



If a subwoofer is not being used, a speaker stand can be used instead. It is important to follow the assembly instructions provided by the manufacturer of the speaker stand. Then, follow steps 2 to 4 as described.

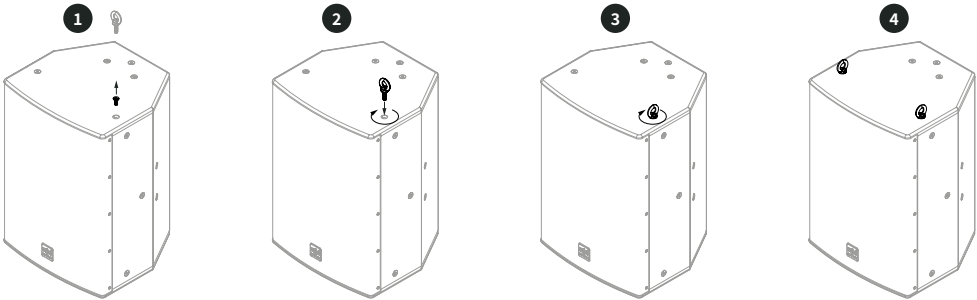
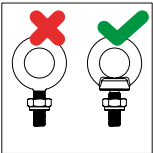
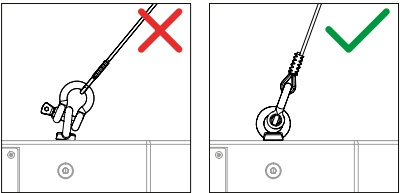


Figure 19. COX 12 MKII - Preparing for flown installation.

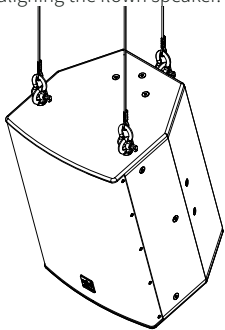


Figure 20. COX 8 MKII - Example of flown installation.

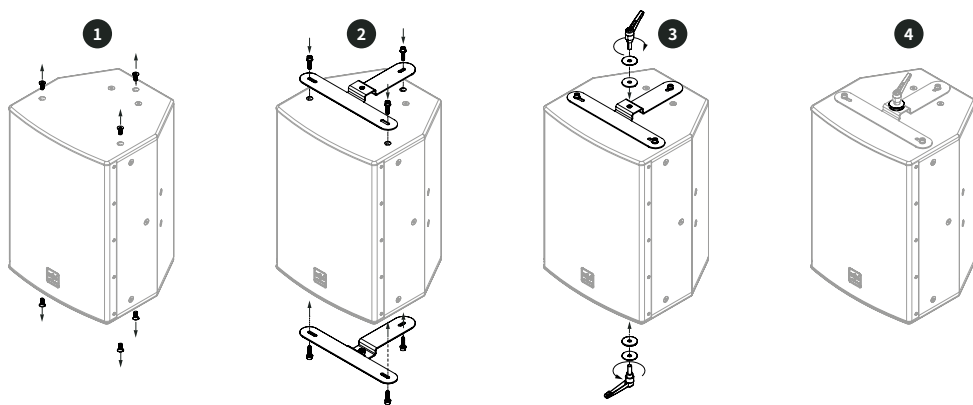


Figure 21a. COX 12 MKII - Installation with Wall Mount Bracket.

- 1 Prepare the handle screws and washers and remove the countersink screws that are screwed in.
- 2 Attach the mounting brackets to the top and bottom of the speaker cabinet as shown. Tighten the bracket with the appropriate screws.
- 3 Place a steel washer and then a silicone washer on the shaft of each handle screw. Tighten the handle screws loosely into the thread in the bracket.
- 4 Turn the handle screws additional 3 or 4 times to keep them in place

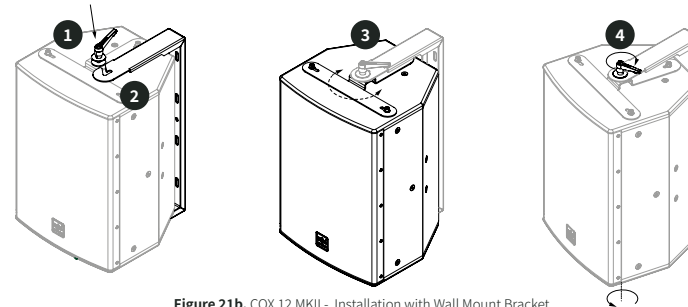


Figure 21b. COX 12 MKII - Installation with Wall Mount Bracket.

- 1 Push the silicone washer close to the cabinet's side panel, and the metal washer close to the handle screw, so the U-bracket arm can easily get between both washers.
- 2 Place the U-bracket over the left and right handle screws. Make sure the U-bracket arms have the silicone washer at the side of the loudspeaker cabinet, and the steel washer on the side of the handle screw. Tighten the handle screws loosely to keep the loudspeaker cabinet in position.
- 3 Make sure that the shaft of each handle screw is completely in the mounting recesses of the U-bracket. Align the speaker to direct the sound towards the desired area.
- 4 Once the speaker has been aligned, tighten the handle screws by hand until the speaker cabinet cannot be rotated any further. Remember to attach the safety catch.

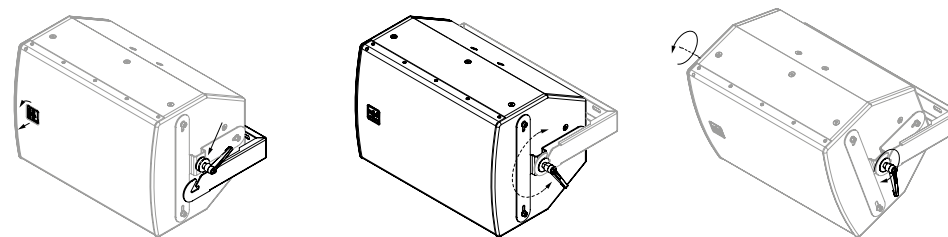


Figure 21c. COX 12 MKII - Installation with Wall Mount Bracket.



When aligning and mounting horizontally, ensure that the wall bracket's opening for holding the clamping lever faces upwards to prevent it from slipping out.



Make sure to use the appropriate mounting materials to attach the wall bracket to the desired position on a load-bearing wall.

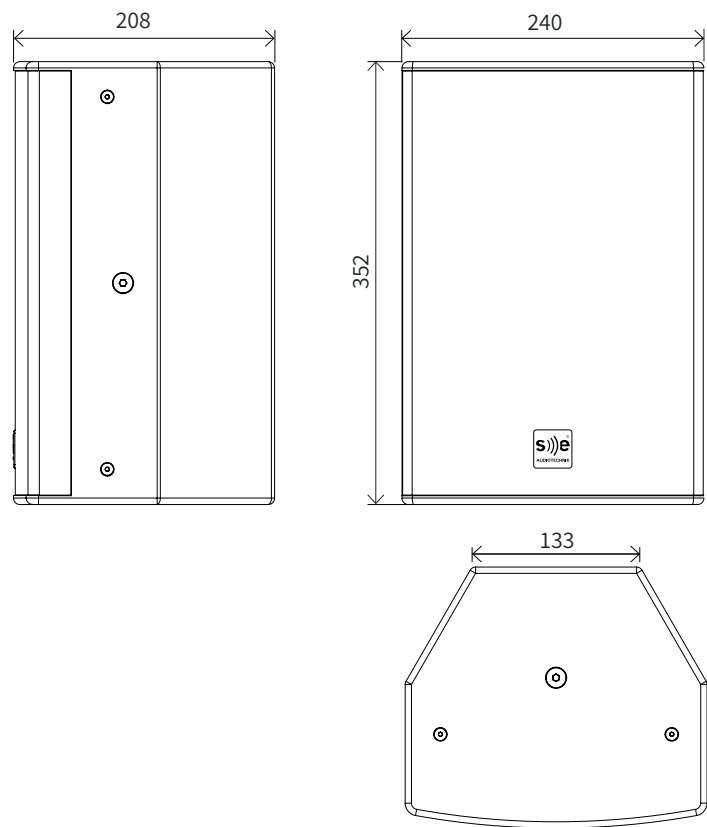


Figure 22. COX 8 MKII views and dimensions. Annotations given in millimeters.

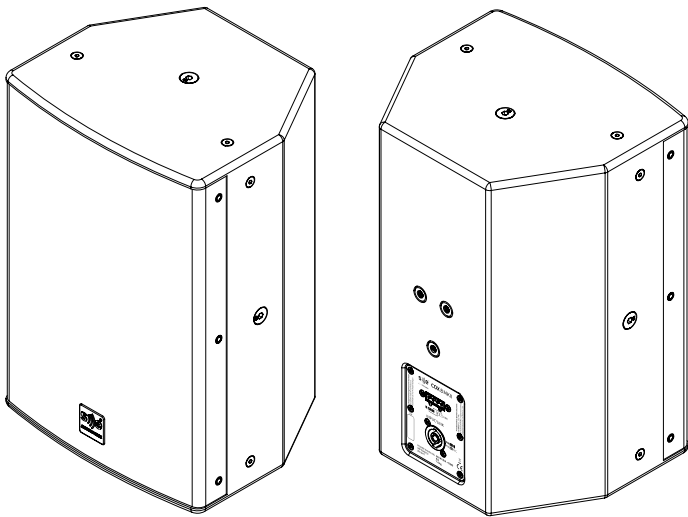


Figure 23. COX 8 MKII isometric views.

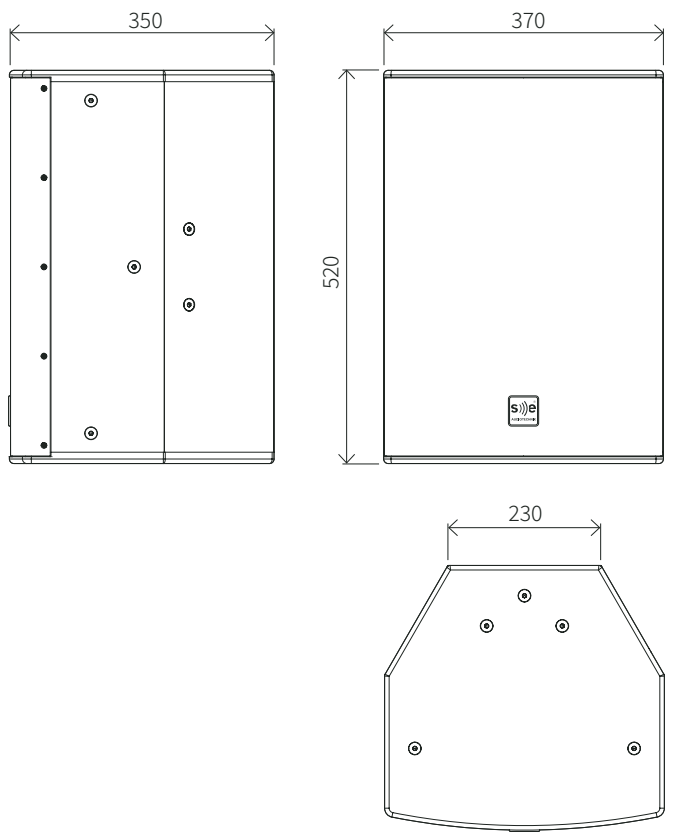


Figure 24. COX 12 MKII views and dimensions. Annotations given in millimeters.

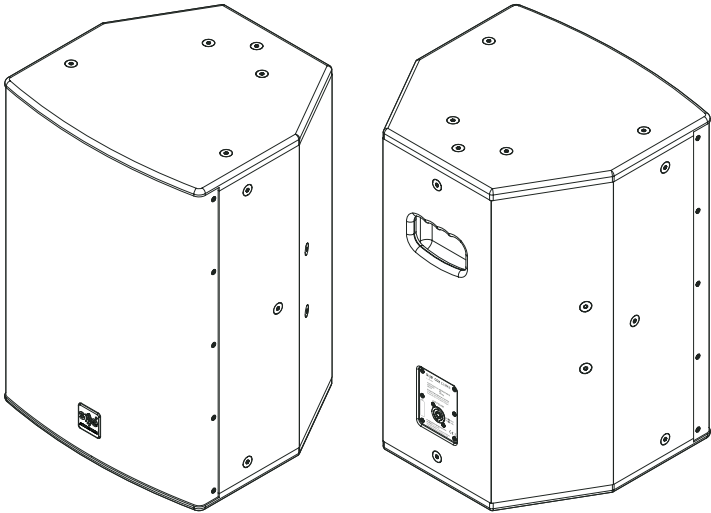


Figure 25. COX 12 MKII isometric views.
